



## **SOLAS COMPLIANCE VGM (On-Dock Scale Authorization) CERTIFICATE**

The U.S. Coast Guard's declared equivalency concedes that terminal weighing practices for on-dock scales in the United States is compliant with SOLAS regulations. As such, all U.S. marine terminals who are equipped to provide gross mass weights can now convey such weight to VOCC – Ocean Carrier, at Shipper/Exporter's request.
